What service areas does Crossroads provide in?

The following areas are currently emerging:

- Pregnancy Resource Center**—Strengthening options in untimely pregnancy; providing safe, confidential, sensitive help in understanding options
- Single Parent Support**—A place where single parents can grow in their parenthood through support, education, & mentoring
- Family & Personal Empowerment**—Optimizing intentional growth and change in families
- Caregiver Support**—Refueling weary caregivers who care for special needs children, medically needy family members, or special circumstances
- Elderly Care**—Embracing life through in-home support, household task assistance, friendship, and resourcing
