"Christ Is Risen! He is Now Here!"

AS WE GATHER

Alleluia! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia! This ancient greeting sounds among us again today, for today the Church celebrates the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Christ has defeated sin, death, and the devil and opened the kingdom of heaven to all believers. Today, we welcome you to come and be a part of God's people who gather to remember and to rejoice in what Christ has done. Alleluia! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

In the early church, the celebration of the Lord's Supper was viewed as a continuation of the Resurrection appearances of the Risen Savior. It was viewed much the same as Jesus saying to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see My hands. Stop doubting and believe." (John 20:27) As Jesus promised, we believe that He is really present in this Sacrament with His very body and His very blood for our forgiveness. We also believe that oneness in doctrine is Biblically affirmed for those who receive the Sacrament together. We therefore ask guests desiring to commune to kindly speak with the pastor before the service.

THE CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- P: Jesus was delivered over to death for our sins.
- C: He was raised to life for our justification. (Romans 4:25)
- P: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- C: But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:8-9)

(Silence for reflection on God's Word and for self-examination.)

- P: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.
- C: Merciful Father, we confess to You that we are nothing apart from You. Your Word describes us as spiritually blind, deaf, and dead by our very nature without Your saving grace. In our thoughts, words, and actions, we have acted as if we do not need You. But we are wrong—dead wrong! Forgive us, Father, for our many sins against You and against one another. By the mercy You show us in the sacrificial death and triumphant resurrection of Jesus Christ, remind us again of the new life and salvation You have freely given. Cleanse and renew us by Your grace that we may rise to newness of life with our risen Lord and Savior. Amen.
- P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ♣ Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.

THE EPISTLE 1 Corinthians 15:19-26 (ESV)

If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For as by a man came death, by a Man has come also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, then at His coming those who belong to Christ. Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power. For He must reign until He has put all His enemies under His feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death.



THE HOLY GOSPEL Luke 24:1-12 (ESV)

P: The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the twenty-fourth chapter.



On the first day of the week, at early dawn, [the women] went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel. And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. Remember how He told you, while He was still in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise." And they remembered His words, and returning from the tomb they told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest. Now it was Mary Magdalene and Johanna and Mary the mother of James and the other women with them who told these things to the apostles, but these words seemed to them an idle tale, and they did not believe them. But Peter rose and ran to the tomb; stooping and looking in, he saw the linen cloths by themselves; and he went home marveling at what had happened.

P: This is the Gospel of the Lord.




THE NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible. THE PRAYER OF THE CHURCH

- P: Let us pray for the whole people of God who live in the perpetual joy of Christ's resurrection and for all people, that they might come to share in those eternal joys. . . . Lord of life and death, at Your chosen time You sent Your only Son, Jesus Christ, to carry our sin to the tree of the cross, and then on the third day You raised Him from the dead. For this we give You thanks and praise saying, This is the day the Lord has made;
- C: let us rejoice and be glad in it.
- P: Blessed Lord, pour out Your Holy Spirit and with power so that we may boldly witness to Christ's resurrection. We pray for ourselves and also for our missionaries and Mission Development Counselors, including Gary Thies and Pastor Steve Schulz. Grant that all who hear the message of our Savior's empty tomb may turn from sin, trust in Christ, receive the forgiveness of sins, and join in saying, This is the day the Lord has made;

- P: Ruler of all, bless the nations with justice and peace. In every government curb the evil of corruption and self-interest, and give leaders who will speak truth and govern wisely. Help us all to set our minds on things above that when Jesus comes again in glory, everyone may say, This is the day the Lord has made;
- C: let us rejoice and be glad in it.
- P: Heavenly Father, rescue those who are captive to prejudice, drugs, or violence. Renew and restore those who are victims of crime, and lead those who serve time in prison to a new and right way of life. Protect all who police our neighborhoods and cities. Give new opportunities to those who seek work and those who long for relief from bad times. Send rain and seasonable weather to bless the time of fieldwork and planting. For Your great mercy and Your protection we once again say, This is the day the Lord has made;
- C: let us rejoice and be glad in it.
- P: Lord of Life, in Christ You showed how You are able to bring hope and life where there is only despair and death. Heal and strengthen those who are ill and recovering, including . . . and all those we remember before You silently in our hearts (silent prayer). Comfort those who weep for loved ones now fallen asleep. Remembering that in our Lord's resurrection we too have new life, help us each day to say, This is the day the Lord has made;

- P: God of all grace, bless the faithful who approach Your altar on this joyous day. As they partake of Your Son's body and blood, bestow on them the fullness of His resurrected life, that they may always give thanks, saving. This is the day the Lord has made:

For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.


