# REFORMATION SUNDAY October 26, 2025 "Going Home the Righteous Way"

#### **AS WE GATHER**

In speaking of the message of the Reformation, Martin Luther stated: "All I have written and taught has been according to my conscience and sworn duty as a humble teacher of the Holy Scripture, for the praise of God, for the benefit and salvation of all Christendom." He knew the message was much more than the man. He wanted his hearers to be assured of their salvation, which is alone in Christ, the Messiah. Through his sermons and hymn texts and writings, he presented the Gospel simply and directly. Today we honor and celebrate his faithful rediscovery of that Good News! Luther's three main themes were:

We are saved by God's <u>Grace Alone</u>, through <u>Faith in Jesus Christ Alone</u>. <u>Scripture Alone (God's Word)</u> is the ultimate authority on God and our life with Him.

Luther's attempts to reform the Roman Catholic church from within failed, but through Luther God restored the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ as the focus of Christian faith and life.

# THE INVOCATION, CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ♣ Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.

# THE PSALM OF THE DAY Psalm 46 (NIV)

- P: God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.
- C: Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea,

- C: There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy place where the Most High dwells.
- P: God is within her, she will not fall; God will help her at break of day.

- C: Come and see what the LORD has done, the desolations He has brought on the earth.

And he said with a loud voice, "Fear God and give Him glory, because the hour of His judgment has come, and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water."

P: This is the Word of the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God.

# THE EPISTLE Romans 3:19-28 (ESV)

Now we know that whatever the Law says it speaks to those who are under the Law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God. For by works of the Law no human being will be justified in His sight, since through the Law comes knowledge of sin. But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the Law, although the Law and

the Prophets bear witness to it—the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by His grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a propitiation by His blood [the sacrifice to pay for sin] to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in His divine forbearance He had passed over former sins. It was to show His righteousness at the present time, so that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith. For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the Law.

P: This is the Word of the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God.

# THE HOLY GOSPEL Luke 18:9-14 (ESV)

P: The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke the eighteenth chapter.

# C: Glory to You, O Lord.

[Jesus] also told this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and treated others with contempt: "Two men went up into the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. The Pharisee, standing by himself, prayed thus: 'God, I thank You that I am not like other men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I get.' But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even lift up his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me, a sinner!' I tell you, this man went down to his house justified, rather than the other. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

P: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

C: Praise to You, O Christ.

#### THE NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father, by whom all things were made; who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. He suffered and was buried. And the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures and ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of the Father. And He will come again with glory to judge both the living and the dead, whose kingdom will have no end. And I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets. And I believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church, I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins, and I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.






